Reminder: Top Ten Things to Keep Waterhaven Wonderful



Trash cans and recycle containers should be placed at the end of your drive before pickup and removed after pickup in a timely manner (within 24 hours).



Trash cans should be screened, landscaped or placed in the garage except for pickup days.



HVAC units should be screened with either fencing or landscaping.



All houses should be landscaped at least in front of the house.



Yards should be mowed and grass should never reach a height that exceeds seven (7) inches.



Grass clippings and debris should be promptly removed from the street.



Streetside parking and parking in the grass is prohibited.



Mailbox lights should be functional so as to turn on at dusk.



Please make sure to stop at the stop signs at the three-way intersection by the pool, playground and trailway entrance. Year round, but definitely during the summer months, this area has high pedestrian traffic with our community's children, pets and adults.



For the safety of all in our community, please observe the 25 mph speed limit, especially around construction sites, blind curves, and community amenities/lots.

We are confident that everyone's desire for Waterhaven is for it to be the very best it can be, and it can be with us all being mindful of a few simple things and working together to make it happen.
